1	Para 15 under GCC Clause 6.2, Section V. Special Conditions of the Contract	What is the reference for the computation of the RMC fund? Is it delivered amount or bid amount? May we request for a copy of the Plans and Programs of DND for the year that will require the RMC fund.	The reference for the computation of the RMC Fund is the amount paid by the Procuring Entity to the Supplier for the delivered POL requirement. The Program of Expenditure (POE) for the RMC fund will be provided to the winning Supplier once approved by the Head of the Procuring Entity.
2	Section VII. Technical Specifications	We would like to ask if you can provide the specifications and product equivalent of the following products (see Lubricants Specification table)	Lubricants with MIL specifications already provide a complete description of the product. For others, see Attachment . Providing product equivalent is tantamount to branding which is prohibited by the procurement law.

In addition the bidder shall submit copies of the first and second envelopes. In the event of any discrepancy between the original and the copies, the original shall prevail"</i></p> <p>It was in these provisions that we seek reconsideration to allow the nine (9) copies of the original to be no longer certified true copies bearing the initials of the bidder/authorized representatives. Bid Data Sheet, the bidder must submit <i>"Duly signed Statement of Conformity with the Schedule of Requirements and Technical Specifications, as enumerated and specified in Section VI and Section VII of the Bidding Documents..."</i></p> <p>Hence, the statement of conformity with the Technical Specifications must form part of the technical components of the bid to be submitted. Nonetheless, the Product Data</p>

			Sheet need not be attached to the bid but should be presented during the Post-Qualification.
5	Section III. Bid Data Sheet, Article 12.1	With reference to Section III. Bid Data Sheet, Article 12.1, TAB C, Attachments to Single Largest Completed Contract, we would like to request that the proof of payment be submitted during the post qualification inspection. Other requirements such as NOA, NTP and Contract are the only supporting documents that will be attached to our Statement of SLCC during the bid submission.	In reference to Clause 12.1(a)(ii.9), Section II. Instruction to Bidders, it was stated that "end user's acceptance or official receipt(s) or sales invoice issued for the contract, if completed, shall be attached to the statements. Considering that the query pertains to the Statement of Single Largest Completed Contract, then it is a requirement that the supporting documents mentioned above is attached to the Statement during bid submission.
6	Section VII. Technical Specifications	With reference to the schedule of requirements for Lot 2, we would like to clarify the specifications for the following products: Lube Oil TBN 40 – What is the required viscosity?	For Marine Grade TBN 40, the requirement for viscosity grade is SAE 40.
7	Section VII. Technical Specifications	What is the technical specifications for: a. 5W-40 (Fully Synthetic) b. SAE 10	a. Viscosity Grade requirement for SAE 5W 40 (Fully Synthetic) is API SN / API CJ-4/SM b. SAE 10 Flash Point, COC: 212°C Specific Gravity at 15.6°C: 0.8708 Viscosity at 40°C, cSt: 27.10 Viscosity at 100°C, cSt: 5.12
8	Section VII. Technical Specifications	Technical Specifications for 10W should be API CF/SF	The Quality Level/Grade of SAE 10W shall be read as "API CF/SF"
