This Supplemental Bid Bulletin is issued to inform prospective bidders of the modifications, amendments, or additional requirements that form part of the Bid Documents for the Close Air Support Aircraft Acquisition Project:

1	<p><b>Question:</b></p> <p>Supplemental Bid Bulletin 15-001-05 Item 7 specifies that live weapons training will be conducted with a variety of munitions at the supplier's training facility. Due to US Department of Defense regulations and Department of Justice, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms oversight, this requirement may be problematic in the United States although supplier will attempt to comply to the extent allowed by the US Government. If unable to fully satisfy this requirement in the United States, <b>would the Philippine Government accept</b> the conduct of this training by supplier following delivery of the first group of Philippine aircraft in the Philippines making use of the <b>newly accepted aircraft</b> and trained Philippine maintenance personnel as compliance with this requirement? This approach is also beneficial to the Philippines in that it will operationally verifying the effectiveness and accuracy of the new aircraft and sensors with actual munitions delivery as opposed to conducting those events on supplier aircraft.</p>	<p>Item 2.
